4. Non burnables
5. Burnables

## Collection dates of all areas

(We collect on holidays!)



Please follow the rules!

- Please take out the separated garbages by 8:30 am on the mornings of designated days.
- Please do not take out the garbage the night before or after collection.
- Don't throw away garbage at other collection points on your commuting route!
- Please take out garbage on the designated days!
- Don't throw away garbage and recyclables from offices, shops and restaurants at the same collection points as households!
- Don't put different types of recyclables in the same bag!

Papers can be thrown away but no cloths on rainy days!

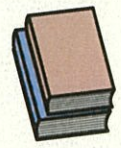
# Papers·Cloths



## Papers

■ Magazines · Books (Journals · Text books · Note books · Pamphlets)

\* Please tie with string

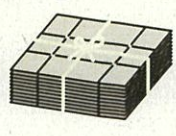
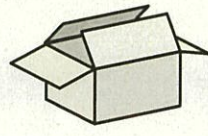
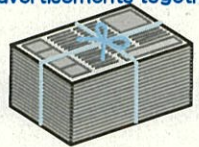


■ News paper (including advertising inserts)

\* Please tie the news paper and advertisements together with string

■ Cardboard

\* Please fold as small as possible and tie with string



■ Paper pack (Milk cartons)

\* Please wash, cut open, dry and tie with string

\* Packs with aluminum inside are considered as [Burnables]



■ Recyclable paper \* Please put inside a bag (Paper bag or clear bag)

· Paper box of snacks · Wrapping paper · Cigarette packs



■ Shredded paper

\* Please put inside a clear bag



· Core of toilet paper and cling films

· Empty tissue boxes

\* Separate the plastic part and throw away as [Plastic containers and packaging]

\* Please do not mix shredded paper

● Non-recyclables...Please throw away as [Burnables]  
Waterproof paper (paper cups, yogurt containers, natto packaging and etc.), thermal paper (receipt papers, fax papers and etc.), photographs, heat-sensitive foam paper, back carbon paper, carbonless paper (e.g copy slip), pigment printing paper (e.g iron print magazine), oiled paper and etc.

## Cloths

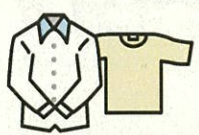
\* Cloths will be recycled as used clothing. Wrecked cloths can also be thrown away. However, cloths that are too dirty cannot be reused so please throw away as [Burnables]

■ Cloths

■ Coats

■ Leather goods

■ Towel / blanket



\* Wash, dry and put in clear bag with buttons and zippers left

\* Please do not throw away on rainy days

● Non-recyclables...Please throw away as [Burnables] or oversized garbage  
Frequently mistaken items [Burnables] Clothes with cotton (a happi coat, ski wear and etc.) , [Oversized garbage] Rug, carpet, quilt and etc.



Items with a Pla-mark are all 「Plastic containers and packaging」 !

# Plastic containers and packaging

Recyclables

Plastic containers and packaging are containers and packagings of items that become unnecessary once the item is taken out or used

This logo is the sign



Items with this logo are all 「Plastic containers and packaging」 !

## Display of logo

Cups : PP,PE

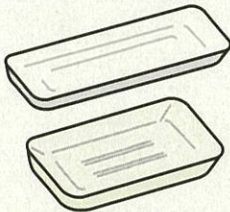

① : Items that are considered as plastic containers and packagings

② : Materials are displayed. The logo insists that the item is 「Plastic containers and packaging」 no matter what material.

■ Styrofoam trays



■ Labels and caps of pet bottles



■ Food packagings



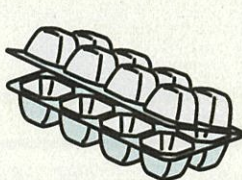
■ Bottles of shampoos and detergents



■ Containers of pudding, cup noodles, bentos and etc.



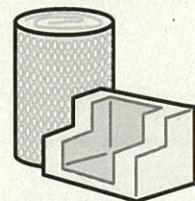
■ Egg cartons



■ Exterior films of cigarettes, tissue boxes and etc.



■ Styrofoam cushioning used in packing home appliances



\* No need to forcibly take off price tag stickers that can't be taken off

## How to throw away plastic containers and packagings



Please empty the contents inside the containers



If the container is dirty, please wipe clean or rinse using water from dish washing



Put in clear bag and throw away on designated dates



Don't open holes in the gas canisters!

# Cans · Bottles · Pet bottles · Waste oil

Recyclables

## Cans



- Seaweed can/ Can / Tea can
- Spray can



- Aluminum can / Steel can



\* Safely open a hole at a safe place once empty

\* Wash with water  
\* Crush aluminum cans

- Non-recyclables...Please throw away as 「Burnables (Metal)」  
Wire hangers, spoons, knives, forks and etc.

## Bottles

\* No need to take off labelling stickers

- Refillable bottles  
Beer bottles / Brown or green sake bottles



- Other bottles  
Juice bottles, ingredient jars, cosmetic jars, alcohol bottles and etc.



\* Please rinse the inside

\* Even if it isn't put in a bag, Refillable bottles can take it out.

\* Wash with water and put in clear bag

- Non-recyclables...Please throw away as 「Burnables (glass)」  
Glass pieces, ceramics and porcelain, flower pots, cups and etc.

## Pet bottles



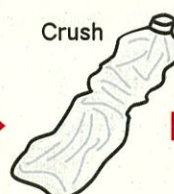
Containers with this logo



Take off the label and cap and wash with water



Crush



Please throw away the labels and caps as 「Plastic containers and packaging」

\* Put in clear bag and throw away

## Waste oil

Salad oil, olive oil, sesame oil, safflower oil, sunflower oil and other vegetable oils



Please put in a pet bottle and throw away after taking out the fried remainings



Please use up the lighters before throwing away because it can be dangerous!

# Non-burnables

## Glass

Main items

■ Glass pieces



■ Ceramics and porcelain



■ Cup



■ Disposable heat pack



\* The packaging of disposable heat packs are [Plastic containers and packaging]

\* Please wrap broken glasses with paper and write 『キケン』 when throwing away

\* Please put in clear bag when throwing away

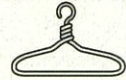
## Metals

Main items

■ Clock



■ Wire hanger



■ Umbrella



■ Rice cooker



\* Please put small items in clear bags

\* Large items do not require to be put into bags. However, if there are several umbrellas, please tie with string

## Lighter



\* Put in a clear bag and write 「ライター」 on the bag and throw away once empty

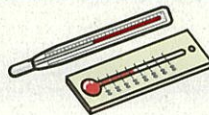
## Dry cell battery



\* Put in clear bag and write 「乾電池」 when throwing away

\* The city cannot dispose rechargeable batteries and button batteries. Please return to the collection boxes at stores

## Mercury thermometers



\* Please put in clear bag and write 「温度計・体温計」 when throwing away

\* Thermometers that are not mercury can be thrown away as [Metals]

## Fluorescent tubes · Light bulbs



\* Please put in a clear bag or original container

\* Please write 「キケン」 on broken items

Lighters and batteries can be thrown away in the same bag.



Please drain raw garbage before throwing away!

# Burnables

Please do not throw away recyclable [Papers · Cloths · Plastic containers and packaging], pet bottles and [waste oil] as [Burnables]



\* Please put in clear bag and tightly tie the bag when throwing away

■ Kitchen waste

\* Please drain kitchen waste before throwing away. Draining can cut down about 10% of the weight.



\* Please cooperate in disposing vegetable waste from home gardening at home

■ Used tissue papers and other dirty paper waste



■ Sea shells, egg shells and etc.



■ Leather goods



■ Stuffed animals · Dolls



■ Plastic goods



■ Video tapes · DVDs · Cassette tapes · CDs



■ Pens · Rulers and other stationeries



■ Paper diapers · Other hygiene products



■ Desiccant · Ice pack



■ Polyethylene tank  
\* Please empty the tank
