Mt.Oyama

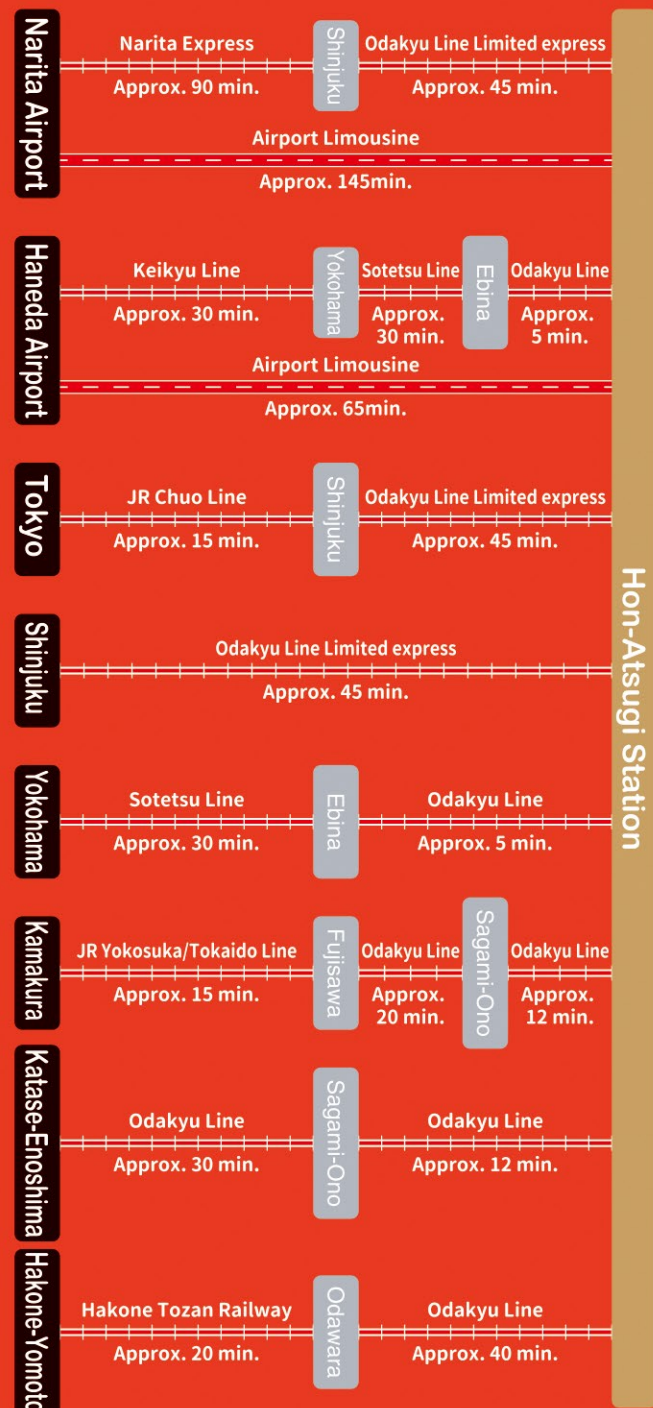
Mt. Oyama lies at the southeastern edge of the Tanzawa mountain range. This 1,252 meter mountain is situated on the border between three cities: Atsugi, Isehara, and Hadano. It is one of the most popular tourist destinations in Kanagawa. Visitors can access Afuri Shrine halfway up the mountain by cable car. In autumn, the shrine bustles with visitors who come to enjoy the Spectacular view of fall foliage. The scenic view from Afuri Shrine has won a high ranking two stars in French travel guide Michelin Green Guide Japon.



Iiyama Hot Spring Resort

Iiyama hot spring resort is located at easternmost area at the foot of Higashitanzawa mountain range amongst what the Japanese refer to as 'satoyama' (woodland villages/towns). The area has been a popular hot spring area amongst the locals for generations. The hot spring is high in alkaline and famous for its beauty benefits as it cleanses the skin and makes it smooth. The area also has Iiyama Kannon Chokokuji Temple (the sixth temple of the Bando 33 Kannon Pilgrimage) and Iiyama Hakusan Forest Park. At this park, the visitors can enjoy seasonal scenery, such as cherry blossoms in the spring and fall foliage in the autumn.

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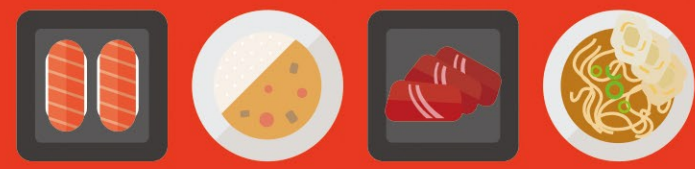

Miyagase

Lake Miyagase is a dammed lake situated in an area called Higashitanzawa. Miyagase Dam is one of the largest dams in the Tokyo Metropolitan Area. During the tourist season the dam releases water (30 cubic meters per second) at a pre-arranged schedule. This releasing of water is a spectacular sight, as the dam temporarily transform into a waterfall in which large volume of water drops 70m and the splashing of water looks almost like smoke. It is a perfect place for a family-outing, with its lakeshore park and a sight-seeing boat that offers a round-trip of the lake.



Higashitanzawa Nanasawa Hot Spring Resort

Higashitanzawa Nanasawa hot spring resort lies on the east side of Mt. Oyama. This area is dotted with traditional Japanese-style inns located in a serene environment. From this hot spring resort you can enjoy the simple, quiet scenery of a mountain village. The hot spring is high in alkaline and good for your skin. Each inn offers a variety of dishes using seasonal ingredients. Visitors can enjoy staying at an inn or book a one-day deal and enjoy bathing in hot spring and a meal without staying the night.
